AP Limited Editions *Art in miniature*

Founded by Anuj Poddar, a businessman of Indian origin based in the USA, AP Limited Editions is one of the rare penmakers to feature lacquer writing instruments using the Japanese technique of maki-e and the highly acclaimed Russian art of miniature painting from Palekh. Anuj Poddar's fascination for pens began when he was a child, as he set out to fulfill his dream of creating his own line. "Each pen is the fruit of my own creative vision or inspired by a painting that I have seen," he explains. His limited editions portray scenes inspired by legends (history, art and fairy tales), such as Ganesha 108 (a number chosen for its 108 different names), which depicts the Hindu god in a Bollywood-esque décor. Using the Russian miniature painting technique known as Palekh, bright colors bring Ganesha, the god of wisdom, good fortune and writing, to life. The Sakura limited edition evokes the famous flowering cherry trees that hold such symbolism within Japan. The maki-e lacquer technique and its successive layers lend poetry to the scene comprised of delicate white flowers and iridescent water. Genuine miniature paintings, the limited editions by Anuj Poddar will bring great art to your beloved desk. ■
